

## CHAPTER 163—H. F. No. 894

*An act relating to the acquisition of airport property by a municipality; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 360.036, by adding a new subdivision thereto.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 360.036, is amended by adding a new subdivision thereto numbered subdivision 6, to read:

**360.036 Subd. 6. Airports, acquisition by municipalities.** *The governing body of any municipality may expend money for the purpose of acquiring property, real or personal, to establish, construct or enlarge an airport or other air navigation facility by purchase, lease or condemnation, irrespective of any limitation by general or special law or charter as to the amount that may be so expended by such governing body provided state or federal funds or funds received by gift have been allocated or otherwise made available to such municipality to reimburse it for the entire amount of such expenditure in excess of the amount authorized by such general or special law or charter; or provided such municipality has obtained funds from the sale of an existing airport, the funds obtained from such sale may be used to acquire land and establish and construct an airport on another site. The acquisition by any such municipality of any airport or airport property heretofore acquired by gift, purchase, lease or condemnation is hereby validated and confirmed irrespective of any limitation by general or special law or charter provision to the contrary notwithstanding.*
