ty having a population according to the last federal census of not less than 49,000, nor more than 50,000, and having not less than 24, nor more than 25, full and fractional townships. It shall be under control of an individual owner or manager and, if located in municipalities other than cities of the first, second, and third class, it may be owned and operated by the municipality as the governing body thereof shall direct.
