Said lands when acquired as herein provided shall be perpetually dedicated for state park purposes and administered in the manner provided for other state parks and shall be known as Bear Head Lake state park.

CHAPTER 386—H. F. No. 509

An act relating to the impounding of motor vehicle registration plates; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 168.041, Subdivisions 1 and 3.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 168.041, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

168.041 **Impounding registration plates and certificates.** Subdivision 1. When any person is convicted of driving a motor vehicle ~~without having a valid drivers license in force, or when any person is convicted of driving a motor vehicle~~ after the suspension or revocation of the drivers license or driving privileges of such person, the court ~~may~~ *shall* require the registration plates and registration certificates of any motor ~~vehicles~~ *vehicle involved in such violation* owned by such person or registered in his name to be surrendered to the court. Upon surrender thereof the court shall issue a receipt therefor.

If the violator is not the owner of such motor vehicle, the court ~~may~~ *shall* require the registration plates and the registration certificate of any motor vehicle used by the violator, with the permission of the owner who had knowledge of the fact that the violator's drivers license had been revoked or suspended ~~in~~ *prior to* the commission of the offense, to be surrendered to the court.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 168.041, Subdivision 3, is amended to read:

Subd. 3. If a person ~~who~~ is convicted of any offense which makes mandatory the revocation of the drivers license of such person ~~has been previously convicted under Minnesota Statutes, Section 171.02, Section 171.24, or Section 170.50, Subdivision 1, or is convicted of driving a motor vehicle without having a valid driver's license in force,~~ the court may require the registration plates and registration certificates of any motor ~~vehicles~~ *vehicle* owned by such person or any motor vehicles registered in his name to be surrendered to the court.

CHAPTER 387—H. F. No. 513

An act relating to certain towns in Freeborn county, granting certain powers possessed by villages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Certain towns in Freeborn county; village powers.** The following towns in Freeborn county, namely, Bancroft, Manchester and Hayward, shall have and possess, in addition to all other powers now or hereafter granted said towns, the power and authority now possessed by villages insofar as enumerated by Minnesota Statutes 1957, Sections 412.221, Subdivisions 3, 6, 8, 9, 11, 14, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 25, 26, 28, 29 and 32; 412.111; 412.191, Subdivision 4; 412.231; 412.491; 412.851; 412.871; 471.62; 110.126; and 429.011 to 429.111.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective as to each specified town named in section 1 only after its approval by a majority of the town board of supervisors of such town and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.
