An act relating to the conciliation court of the city of Minneapolis; disposal of records; amending Laws 1955, Chapter 129, Section 2, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1955, Chapter 129, Section 2, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. Clerk of municipal court; duties, records. (a) The clerk of the municipal court shall serve as the clerk of the conciliation court. He shall delegate deputy clerks of the municipal court to assist him in performing his duties under this act. The clerk shall keep such records and accounts and perform such duties as may be prescribed by the judges. He shall account for and pay over to the City of Minneapolis all fees received by him in the same fashion as required in his capacity as clerk of municipal court.

(b) The clerk may, upon the consent of all the judges of municipal court of the City of Minneapolis, destroy or dispose of all the following files and records of said court, which have been on file for more than twenty years:

- (1) Complaint files;
- (2) Transcript receipts;
- (3) Cash receipt books;
- (4) Cancelled checks.
