## CHAPTER 92-S. F. No. 112

## [Not Coded]

An act relating to the compensation of the register of deeds and the registrar of titles of Lake county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Lake county, register of deeds, registrar of titles, salary. The board of county commissioners of Lake county shall fix the annual salary for the combined office of register of deeds and registrar of titles at not less than \$6,000, nor more than \$7,500.

Sec. 2. Fees. If the board of county commissioners of Lake county sets the salary of the combined office of register of deeds and registrar of titles as provided in section 1, then and at that time, all fees collected by the combined office of register of deeds and registrar of titles shall be paid to the county in the manner, and at the times prescribed by the county board. No such official shall then receive any such fees as additional compensation.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the board of county commissioners of Lake county in compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

## CHAPTER 93-S. F. No. 288

An act relating to the salary of the county auditor and county treasurer in Freeborn county; amending Laws 1957, Chapter 314, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1957, Chapter 314, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. Freeborn county, salaries of auditor and treasurer. In any Freeborn county having an assessed valuation over \$20,000,000 and less than \$23,000,000 exclusive of money and credits, over 34,000 and less than 25,000 inhabitants according to the 1950 federal census and over 17 and less than 25 full and fractional townships, the county board may increase the annual salary of the county auditor and county treasurer, in addition to the salary now received by them in an amount not to exceed \$3,000 per annum.

Sec. 2. Validation previous payments. Payments of salaries heretofore paid in accordance with and since the enactment of Laws 1957, Chapter 314, are hereby legalized and validated.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the county of Freeborn and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

CHAPTER 94-S. F. No. 97

An act relating to the salaries of the auditor and treasurer of Jackson county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Jackson county, auditor and treasurer, salary. The board of county commissioners of Jackson county shall set the annual salary of the county auditor and county treasurer at not less than \$6,500 or more than \$7,500.

Sec. 2. Cost of living increase. The salaries set forth in section 1 shall constitute base salaries and the auditor and treasurer shall be entitled to any cost of living increases hereafter granted under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.43.

Sec. 3. Fees and payments. Nothing contained in section 1 of this act shall be construed as limiting the right of such officers to collect and retain fees, per diem payments, or any other payment which they are now authorized to collect in addition to the stated amount of their monthly salary.
