Subd. 2. Said county auditor and county treasurer shall be included under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 375.43, and acts amendatory thereof.

Subd. 3. Nothing contained in this act shall be construed as limiting the right of such officers to collect and retain fees, per diem payments, or any other payment which they are now authorized to collect in addition to the stated amount of their yearly salary.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective upon approval by a majority vote of the governing body of the county of Murray, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

CHAPTER 23—H. F. No. 101

An act authorizing the issuance of bonds by independent school district No. 316 (Coleraine), Minnesota, and the levy of taxes for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Independent school district No. 316; bonds.** Independent School District No. 316, state of Minnesota, situated in Itasca county and including within its corporate limits the village of Coleraine and other territory, is hereby authorized to issue not to exceed \$200,000 of its negotiable coupon general obligation bonds for the purpose of retiring certificates of indebtedness or interest thereon issued in the year 1961 under Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 471.75, Subdivision 4. Such bonds shall be authorized by a resolution of the school board adopted by a favorable vote of not less than two-thirds of its members elect, and shall be sold and issued in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1957, Sections 475.54 through 475.57 and 475.60 through 475.74 in such amounts and at such times during the year 1961 as may be determined by the school board without approval of the electors being required for their issuance.

Sec. 2. The school board may levy the taxes required by law for the payment of said bonds and interest thereon within existing tax limitations including per capita limitations.

Sec. 3. The authority granted by this act is in addition to and not a limitation on any other powers of the said district with respect to the issuance and payment of bonds or certificates of indebtedness, except that the bonds issued hereunder from time to time outstanding shall be included in the net debt of the district for the purpose of the limitations thereon prescribed by Minnesota Statutes 1957, Chapter 475.

Sec. 4. This law shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the members of the school board of said district and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

Sec. 5. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to limit or affect the jurisdiction or order of the district court in any pending action involving Independent School District No. 316.

CHAPTER 24—H. F. No. 225

An act appropriating moneys to the legislature and the branches thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Legislature; appropriation. Subdivision 1. There are appropriated from the general revenue fund in the state treasury to the legislature and the branches thereof the moneys designated in this section, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Subd. 2. For the senate
 For salaries, supplies, and ex-
 penses \$125,000

Subd. 3. For the house of representatives
 For salaries, supplies, and ex-
 penses \$285,000
