Sec. 2. Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 12, Section 2, is amended to read:

Sec. 2. The salary herein provided for shall continue until June 30, ~~1961~~ 1963. At least ~~ninety~~ 90 days prior to June 30th of each odd year commencing in ~~1961~~ 1963 the city council shall by resolution set the salary of the city council for the following two years at such figure as it may determine not in excess of ~~\$7,000~~ \$7,750 unless otherwise provided by charter amendment.

Sec. 3. *This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority vote of the city council of the city of Minneapolis, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.*

EXTRA SESSION

CHAPTER 44—S. F. No. 32

[Not Coded]

*An act relating to the municipal court of the city of Minneapolis; providing for a clerk and deputy clerks of the court and their classification and salaries; repealing Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 7, Sections 1 to 4.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Minneapolis municipal court, clerks.** The municipal court established in the city of Minneapolis shall have a clerk of court, one chief deputy clerk, three assistant chief deputy clerks, twelve senior deputy clerks, and such number of junior deputy clerks as the clerk of court, with the approval of the judges, deems necessary.

Sec. 2. **Annual salaries.** The annual salary of the clerks named in section 1 are:

Clerk of Court	\$9220
Chief Deputy Clerk	7500
Assistant Chief Deputy Clerks, each	6960
Senior Deputy Clerks, each	6300 to 6720
Junior Deputy Clerks, each	4700 to 6080

Sec. 3. **Minimum salaries, increases.** Each junior deputy clerk and each senior deputy clerk shall serve in his classification for one year at the minimum salary for that classification, and his salary shall be increased at the end of each year's service by \$300 until such salaries reach the maximum for such classification. Deputy clerks returning from active service in the armed forces of the United States shall receive automatic salary increases in the same fashion as though the time spent in said active service had been spent as a deputy clerk. With the approval of the judges senior deputy clerks may be started in that classification at a salary more than the minimum and may be granted raises in excess of \$300 per year by the clerk. All senior deputy clerks and junior deputy clerks receiving the maximum salary at the time of passage of this act shall continue to receive such maximum salary.

Sec. 4. **Retroactive.** The provisions of section 2 are retroactive to January 1, 1961. The salaries set forth in section 2 are payable out of the treasury of the city in semi-monthly installments.

Sec. 5. **Repealer.** Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 7, Sections 1 to 4 are repealed.
