

none, then before entering the intersection and shall remain standing until a green indication is shown, *except as follows:*

*The driver of a vehicle which is stopped as close as practicable at the entrance to the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, if none, then at the entrance to the intersection in obedience to a red or stop signal, and with the intention of making a right turn may make such right turn, after stopping, if an official sign has been erected permitting such movement, but shall yield the right of way to pedestrians and other traffic lawfully proceeding through the intersection.*

(2) Unless otherwise directed by a pedestrian-control signal as provided in subdivision 6 of this section, pedestrians facing a steady red signal shall not enter the roadway.

(d) In the event an official traffic-control signal is erected and maintained at a place other than an intersection, the provisions of this section are applicable except those which can have no application. Any stop required shall be made at a sign or marking on the pavement indicating where the stop shall be made, but in the absence of any such sign or marking the stop shall be made at the signal.

#### CHAPTER 32—H. F. No. 294

*An act relating to the executive council, and depositories to receive state funds; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 9.031, Subdivision 8.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 9.031, Subdivision 8, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. **Depositories for state funds; surplus funds; interest.** Depositories shall be divided into two classes to be known as active and inactive. A depository may be designated as a depository of both classes.

All state funds deposited in active depositories are subject to withdrawal by the state treasurer upon demand and no interest shall be charged on these deposits.

Surplus funds not required to meet the state's current disbursements shall be deposited for a definite period in inactive depositories and interest shall be paid on these deposits at a rate of not less than one percent ~~nor more than three percent~~ per annum *nor more than the maximum rate authorized to be paid by Minnesota state banks other than mutual savings banks*. This rate shall be fixed by the executive council in accordance with the current rate upon similar deposits.

CHAPTER 33—S. F. No. 409

*An act relating to elections in common and independent school districts; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 123.11, Subdivision 2; and Section 123.32, Subdivision 8.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 123.11, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **School districts; elections; tie votes.** The annual meeting shall have power to elect by ballot officers of the district. In all elections or vote by ballot, the clerk shall record the names of all voters participating therein and the chairman shall appoint two electors who with the assistance of the clerk shall supervise the balloting and canvass the votes. *If any candidates receive an equal number of votes for an office, the board shall resolve the tie by lot.*

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 123.32, Subdivision 8, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. After canvassing the election, the board shall issue a certificate of election to the candidate for each office who received the largest number of votes cast for the office. *If any candidates receive an equal number of votes for an office, the board shall resolve the tie by lot.* The clerk shall deliver such certificate to the person entitled thereto by registered mail, and each person so certified shall file an acceptance and oath of office in writing with the school district clerk within 30 days of the date of mailing of the certificate. A person who fails to qualify prior to the time specified shall be deemed
