## CHAPTER 935—S.F.No.615

An act relating to the reimbursement of counties by the state for welfare costs expended by the counties to certain Indians; appropriating money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [245.765] PUBLIC WELFARE; INDIANS; REIM-BURSEMENT OF COUNTIES; APPROPRIATION. Subdivision 1. The commissioner of public welfare, to the extent that state and federal money is available therefor, shall reimburse any county for all welfare costs expended by the county to any Indian who is an enrolled member of the Red Lake Band of Chippewa Indians and resides upon the Red Lake Indian Reservation. The commissioner may advance payments to a county on an estimated basis subject to audit and adjustment at the end of each state fiscal year.

Subd. 2. The commissioner may promulgate rules for the carrying out of the provisions of subdivision 1. He may negotiate for and accept grants from the United States for the purposes of this act.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated for the biennium commencing July 1, 1971 to the commissioner of public welfare from the general fund in the state treasury the sum of \$100,000 for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this act.
