An act appropriating funds for the payment of expenses in connection with the 1971 meeting of the National Legislative Conference.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. NATIONAL LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE; AP-PROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the general fund to the chief clerk of the house of representatives and the secretary of the senate the total sum of \$85,000, to be jointly expended by such officials in payment of expenses in connection with the 1971 meeting of the National Legislative Conference to be held in Minnesota. No expenditure of funds appropriated by this section shall be made until the chief clerk and secretary have consulted with the senate committee on rules and administration and the house committee on rules and legislative administration or their designees and received their recommendations, which shall be advisory only.

Sec. 2. This act is in effect from and after final enactment.

## CHAPTER 126—H.F.No.1570

An act relating to education; providing for school board elections in dissolved Independent School District No. 37 and attaching districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 37; ELECTIONS. The 1971 annual election in the school district or districts to which dissolved Independent School District No. 37 of Beltrami county is to be attached pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 122.44, shall be conducted as if the attachment had become effective 45 days prior to the election; provided that the final order of the county board has been issued in accordance with the provisions of section 122.44, subdivision 5, and no appeal has been filed under section 127.25. The board of the surviving district shall make such provisions for the election as are necessary, and qualified persons
