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time of the filing of the first paper therein, and the sum of $\$2\,\3 from the defendant or other adverse or intervening party, or any one or more of several defendants, or other adverse or intervening parties appearing separately from the others, to be collected when his or their appearance is entered in such action or proceeding or when the first paper on his or their part is filed therein. Such law library fees shall be costs in the case, and taxable as such, and shall be allotted for the support of said library.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the board of county commissioners of Ramsey county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 313—H.F.No.1670

An act relating to the village of Champlin; salaries of mayor and councilmen.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. CHAMPLIN, VILLAGE OF; OFFICIALS' SALA-RIES. Subdivision 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 412.181, to the contrary, the village council of the village of Champlin may by ordinance fix the salary of the mayor at not more than \$80 per month and the salaries of the councilmen at not more than \$60 per month until such time as the fixing of such salaries is authorized under section 412.181, after which time the ordinance authorized by this act shall remain in effect until amended or repealed by the council.

Subd. 2. The village council may make the ordinance authorized by this section retroactive to January 1, 1971.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect when approved by the village council of the village of Champlin, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
