An act relating to the public employees retirement association; survivor benefits; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 353.31, by adding a subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 353.31, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 12. P.E.R.A.; SURVIVOR BENEFITS. Whenever subsequent to November 1, 1964, but prior to December 1, 1964, a member died whose surviving spouse received survivor benefits under subdivision 1 of this section and said spouse thereafter remarried and thereby forfeited the right to benefits and said marriage was annulled prior to September 26, 1970, said spouse shall again be entitled to survivor benefits pursuant to said subdivision 1. Benefits hereunder shall commence with the first day of the month next succeeding date of enactment of this subdivision.

CHAPTER 336—H.F.No.2193

An act relating to the town of Irondale; tax levy for town purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. IRONDALE, TOWN OF; TAX LEVY. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Irondale in the county of Crow Wing may levy a tax not to exceed five mills on the dollar of the taxable valuation of the town for town purposes.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the town board of Irondale, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
