

## CHAPTER 439—H.F.No.1933

[Not Coded]

*An act relating to Pipestone county; fees of registered abstractors who are county employees.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. PIPESTONE COUNTY; REGISTERED ABTRACTOR; FEES.** Any fee paid to a registered abstractor or to any other person performing like services where such abstractor or other person is an employee of Pipestone county including but not limited to the register of deeds and where such services are performed at the Pipestone county court house or during the regular working hours of such employee shall be deemed paid to Pipestone county and such employee shall pay any fee so received to the Pipestone county treasurer, the provisions of chapter 386 or any other statute to the contrary notwithstanding.

**Sec. 2. LOCAL APPROVAL.** This act takes effect when approved by the county board of Pipestone county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

**CHAPTER 440—H.F.No.2188**

*An act authorizing the village of Silver Bay in Lake county and the villages of Babbitt, Hoyt Lakes and Mountain Iron in St. Louis county to establish a general revenue reserve funds.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. SILVER BAY, BABBITT, HOYT LAKES AND MOUNTAIN IRON, VILLAGES OF; GENERAL REVENUE RESERVE FUNDS.** Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary the village of Silver Bay in Lake county and the villages of Babbitt, Hoyt Lakes and Mountain Iron in St. Louis county may each establish by ordinance a general revenue reserve fund.

**Sec. 2.** The council of any of the villages named in section 1, to support such fund, may in any year transfer general revenue funds to the general revenue reserve fund. In any year that the tax receipts
