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CHAPTER 523—H.F.No.1987

*An act relating to the weed inspector in the city of Minneapolis; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 18.231, by adding a subdivision.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 18.231, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 3a. MINNEAPOLIS, CITY OF; WEED INSPECTOR. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 3, the governing body of the city of Minneapolis shall appoint or designate an employee of such city to act as local weed inspector, at such compensation as it shall determine.

The commissioner shall be sent notice within ten days of the appointment or designation.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Minneapolis, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
