Each license certificate issued on or before July 1, 1964, shall be on an all plastic or laminated plastic card with the identifying information embossed thereon.

Subd. 2. Upon payment of the required fee for a driver's license bearing a colored photograph, the department may issue to every applicant, the age of sixteen years or over, who does not physically qualify for a driver's license, or any person not currently licensed to drive, who does not intend to apply for a driver's license under this section or who wishes to discontinue driving and surrenders his current driver's license, a nonqualification certificate. The certificate shall bear thereon a distinguishing number assigned to the applicant, the full name, date of birth, residence address, a description of the applicant in such manner as the commissioner deems necessary, and a space upon which the applicant shall write his usual signature with pen and ink.

Each nonqualification certificate shall be on an all plastic or laminated plastic card of a distinguishing color and plainly marked "non-driver."

Subd. 3. The expiration date of each nonqualification certificate of applicants under the age of 65 shall be the birthday of the applicant in the fourth year following the date of issuance of the nonqualification certificate. Nonqualification certificates issued to applicants age 65 or over shall be valid for the lifetime of the applicant.

Sec. 3. This act shall apply to every application for a nonqualification certificate, submitted on or after January 1, 1972.

CHAPTER 660—S.F.No.804

An act relating to registration of title to real estate; increasing charges on registration; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 508.74.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 508.74, is amended to read:

508.74 REGISTRATION OF TITLES; FEES. Upon the original registration of land, and also upon the registration of any land by the heirs or devisees of any deceased person, there shall be paid to the registrar one tenth two-tenths of one percent of the full and true value of the land, exclusive of improvements, as determined by the last official assessment for general taxation, or one dollar five dollars, whichever is the greater. Provided that, in the counties of Hennepin and Ramsey the required fee shall be one-tenth of one percent of the full and true value of the land, exclusive of improvements, or one dollar, whichever is the greater. For the issuance and registration of the new certificate of title there shall be paid to the registrar the sum of two dollars, in addition to any other sum prescribed by law, which shall be disposed of in the manner provided by section 508.75.

CHAPTER 661—S.F.No.1051

An act relating to certain governmental offices; increasing per diem allowances and mileage for the state soil and water conservation commission, and per diem allowances for the water resources board; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Sections 40.03, Subdivision 3; 40.06, Subdivision 2; and 105.71, Subdivision 3.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 40.03, Subdivision 3, is amended to read:

Subd. 3. SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION; OFFICERS; PER DIEM; QUORUM; BONDS. The commission shall designate its chairman, and may annually, from time to time, change such designation. A member of the commission shall hold office so long as he shall retain the office by virtue of which he shall be serving on the commission. A majority of the commission shall constitute a quorum, and the concurrence of a majority in any matter within their duties shall be required for its determination. The ex officio members of the commission shall receive no compensation for their services on the commission, but shall be entitled to expenses, including traveling expenses, necessarily incurred in the discharge of their duties on the commission. The other members of said commission shall receive—\$20_\$35 per day for each day while engaged in the performance of their official duties and shall be
