## EXTRA SESSION CHAPTER 39—S.F.No.133

An act relating to the city of Saint Paul; authorizing the condemnation of easements pursuant to its home rule city charter.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. ST. PAUL, CITY OF; CONDEMNATION OF EASEMENTS. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 117, as amended by Laws 1971, Chapter 595, the city of Saint Paul, when exercising its right of eminent domain, may condemn and acquire easements for slopes, cuts, fills and the right to remove lateral support in connection with improving alleys and streets pursuant to the condemnation procedures contained in its home rule city charter.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Saint Paul and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

## EXTRA SESSION CHAPTER 40—S.F.No.158

An act relating to certain employees in the classified service of Independent School District No. 709.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 709; EMPLOYEES CLASSIFICATION. Notwithstanding Laws 1971, Chapter 683, or any other law to the contrary, a person employed by Independent School District No. 709 of St. Louis county on the effective date of Laws 1971, Chapter 683, in the position of deputy clerk, purchasing agent, or supervisor, other than positions requiring certification by the state board of education, shall remain in the classified service of the district. Upon termination of employment by an incumbent in any of the above positions, the position shall become exempt from the classified service.
