

CHAPTER 228—S.F.No.1187

An act relating to persons with a motor disability; authorizing the use of rubber stamps as the legal signatures of such persons; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 645.44, Subdivision 14.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 645.44, Subdivision 14, is amended to read:

Subd. 14. **LEGAL SIGNATURE; MOTOR DISABILITY; USE OF RUBBER STAMP.** "Written" and "in writing" may include any mode of representing words and letters, ~~except that~~. The signature of a person, when required by law, (a) must be in the handwriting of the person or, (b) if he be unable to write, (i) his mark or his name written by some person at his request and in his presence or, (ii) by a rubber stamp facsimile of his actual signature, mark, or a signature of his name or a mark made by another person and adopted for all purposes of signature by the person with a motor disability and affixed in his presence.

CHAPTER 229—S.F.No.1287

An act relating to county courts; providing for retirement of judges before age 70 who have served ten years or more; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 487.06, Subdivisions 2 and 4.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 487.06, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **COUNTY COURT; JUDGES; RETIREMENT.** If at the expiration of the judge's term as probate judge, he is over 65 years and under 70 years and has served as provided in subdivision 1 for a period of 10 years, he shall, ~~upon reaching the age of 70 years,~~ be entitled to receive one half the compensation allotted to his office for the year 1970, as amended by Extra Session Laws 1971, Chapter 32, Section 26, for the remainder of his life reduced,
