

**[145.425] PUBLIC HEALTH; PAY TOILETS IN PUBLIC PLACES PROHIBITED.** Pay toilets and urinals in public places, public conveyances or public buildings are prohibited unless at least one half of the available toilets in the same area or rest room are free and maintained at the same standards of sanitation and upkeep. Violation of this section is a misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. This act is effective July 1, 1975.

*An act relating to adoptions; annulment of decree after discovery of defect; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 259.30.*

Section 1. **ADOPTION; ANNULMENT OF DECREE.** Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 259.30, is repealed.

**CHAPTER 217—H.F.No.231**

*An act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing the issuance of special license plates to physically handicapped persons; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 168.021.*

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:**

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 168.021, is amended to read:

**168.021 MOTOR VEHICLES; LICENSE PLATES FOR PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PERSONS.** Subdivision 1. **SPECIAL PLATES; APPLICATION FOR ISSUANCE.** Where a motor vehicle is owned or primarily operated by a physically handicapped person, the owner may apply for and secure from the registrar of motor vehicles two license number plates with attached emblems, one plate to be attached to the front, and one to the rear license number plate of the vehicle. Application for issuance of these emblems-plates shall be made on or before July 1, 1963-March 1, 1976, or where the person acquires the vehicle after such date, when he first applies for its registration.
