An act relating to health care; requiring certain insurance policies and health care plans to provide benefits for health care services rendered in free standing ambulatory surgical centers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MIN-NESOTA:

Section 1. [62A.153] HEALTH INSURANCE; FREE STANDING AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTERS. No policy or plan of health, medical, hospitalization, or accident and sickness insurance regulated under chapter 62A, or subscriber contract provided by a nonprofit health service plan corporation regulated under chapter 62C shall be issued, renewed, continued, delivered, issued for delivery or executed in this state, or approved for issuance or renewal in this state by the commissioner of insurance unless the policy, plan or contract specifically provides coverage for a health care treatment or service rendered by a free standing ambulatory surgical center or facilities offering ambulatory medical service 24 hours a day seven days a week, which are not part of a hospital, but have been reviewed and approved by the state board of health to provide the treatment or service, on the same basis as coverage provided for the same health care treatment or service rendered by a hospital.

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 462.364, is amended to read:

462.364 MINNEAPOLIS, CITY OF; REZONING; REPEAL. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 412.221, Subdivision 29, 462.01 to 462.11, 462.18 to 462.23, 465.21 to 465.25 and 471.26 to 471.33 are repealed. Inconsistent special laws and general laws of special application are superseded by sections 462.351 to 462.364 to the extent of inconsistency. Nothing in sections 462.351 to 462.364 is to be construed to affect, alter or modify the provisions of Special Laws of 1887, Chapter 108, or Laws 1933, Chapter 93; or Laws 1963, Chapter 405.
