Ch. 345

Section 1. UTILITY PAYMENT.

Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the city of Medina may pay to a public utility company not more than \$39,762 to finance the construction, by the company, of certain natural gas transmission facilities to be located in the city.

Sec. 2. REFUNDS.

The city may provide by contract with the utility for the refund without interest to the city of all or a portion of the payments made upon the terms and conditions agreed upon in the contract.

Sec. 3. PURPOSE.

The authorization granted by this act is for the purpose of allowing the city to attain its goals of stimulating economic development in the city and surrounding area and is declared to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the state.

## Sec. 4. LOCAL APPROVAL.

<u>This act is effective the day after compliance by the city council of the city</u> of <u>Medina with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes</u>, section 645.021, subdivision 3.

## CHAPTER 346-H.F.No. 2143

An act relating to utilities; permitting certain energy cost adjustments; amending Minnesota Statutes 1984, section 216B.16, subdivision 7.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1984, section 216B.16, subdivision 7, is amended to read:

Subd. 7. ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENTS. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the commission may permit a public utility to file rate schedules containing provisions for the automatic adjustment of charges for public utility service in direct relation to changes in: (1) federally regulated wholesale rates for energy delivered through interstate facilities; (2) direct costs for natural gas delivered; or (3) costs for fuel used in generation of electricity or the manufacture of gas.
