LAWS of MINNESOTA for 1987

<u>The county and state shall provide a proper conveyance.</u> The price may not be less than the appraised value of the property.

The size and location of the property do not allow the property to be developed for public use and it is no longer beneficial for state ownership.

This act is effective the day following final enactment.

# CHAPTER 35-H.F.No. 400

An act relating to game and fish; authorizing commissioner to allow a person to take two deer; amending Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 97B.301, subdivision 4.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 97B.301, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. **EXPERIMENTAL** <u>TAKING</u> TWO DEER. The commissioner may, by order, allow a person to take two deer <del>during each of the 1986 and 1987 ealendar years</del>. The commissioner shall prescribe the conditions for taking the second deer including:

(1) taking by firearm or archery;

(2) obtaining an additional license; and

(3) payment of a fee not more than the fee for a firearms deer license.

## CHAPTER 36-H.F.No. 424

An act relating to the military; authorizing the adjutant general to delegate certain duties to subordinates; amending Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 190.16, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 190.16, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

<u>Subd.</u> 7. DELEGATION OF CONTRACT AUTHORITY. The adjutant general may delegate to subordinate employees the exercise of contract execution and administration authority which the adjutant general holds under a delegation by the commissioner of administration pursuant to section 16B.05, subdivision 1. A delegation by the adjutant general must be made by written order, filed with the secretary of state.

# CHAPTER 37-S.F.No. 457

An act relating to commerce; regulating collection agencies and those acting under the authority of a collection agency; providing cash deposits in lieu of the required bond; establishing prohibited practices; prescribing the enforcement powers of the commissioner; amending Minnesota Statutes 1986, sections 332.31, by adding a subdivision; 332.33; 332.34; 332.37; and 332.40, subdivision 3.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 332.31, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 6. COLLECTOR. <u>"Collector" is a person acting under the authority</u> of a collection agency under section 332.31, subdivision 3, and on its behalf in the business of collection for others an account, bill, or other indebtedness except as otherwise provided in this chapter.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 332.33, is amended to read:

332.33 LICENSES.

Subdivision 1. **REQUIREMENT.** Except as hereinafter otherwise provided in this chapter, no person shall conduct within this state a collection agency or engage within this state in the business of collecting claims for others as defined in sections 332.31 to 332.45, without having first applied for and obtained a license.

Subd. 2. **PENALTY.** Any <u>A</u> person who shall earry <u>carries</u> on business as a collection agency <u>or acts as a collector</u> without first having obtained a license pursuant to sections 332.31 to 332.45, or who shall earry <u>carries</u> on such this business after the revocation, suspension, or expiration of any <u>a</u> license shall be is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Subd. 3. TERM. Licenses granted issued or renewed by the commissioner of commerce under sections 332.31 to 332.45 shall expire on June 30. All renewals of licenses shall likewise expire on June 30. Each license shall plainly state the name and business address of the licensee, and shall be posted in a
