### CHAPTER 447-H.F.No. 2419

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 626.05, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 3. CRIME. The term "crime" as used in sections 626.04 to 626.17 includes (1) those offenses defined as crimes in section 609.02, subdivision 1, and (2) all violations of municipal ordinances for which a misdemeanor sentence may be imposed.

## CHAPTER 448-H.F.No. 2469

An act relating to agriculture; regulating sales of anhydrous ammonia; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 239.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [239.81] ANHYDROUS AMMONIA.

Anhydrous ammonia may be sold at the retail level to any buyer using a temperature correctable liquid meter.

#### CHAPTER 449—H.F.No. 2529

An act relating to alcoholic beverages; defining importers as brewers in the beer wholesaling act; amending Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 325B.01, subdivision 4.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 325B.01, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. "Brewer" means every licensed brewer or importer of beer located within or without the state of Minnesota, who enters into an "agreement" with any beer wholesaler licensed to do business in the state of Minnesota.
