## CHAPTER 14-S.F.No. 7

An act relating to crimes; clarifying that alcoholic beverages are prohibited in public elementary and secondary schools; amending Minnesota Statutes 1990, section 624.701, subdivisions 1 and $1 a$.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1990, section 624.701, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. Except as otherwise provided in subdivision 1a, any person who introduces or possesses an alcoholic beverage, as defined in section 340A.101, on any public elementary or secondary school ground; or in any seheotheuse or public elementary or secondary school buildings is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1990, section 624.701, subdivision 1a, is amended to read:

Subd. 1a. EXCEPTIONS. Subdivision 1 does not apply to the following:
(1) experiments in laboratories;
(2) these organizations a person who have has been issued a temporary Hieenses license to sell nonintoxicating malt liquor pursuant to under section 340A.403, subdivision $2_{2}$ or intoxicating liquor under section 340A.404, subdivision 10; or
(3) any a person possessing nonintoxicating malt liquor or intoxicating liguor as a result of a purchase from these orgations a person or organization holding a temporary tieenses purstat to license under section 340A.403, subdivision $2 \hat{j}_{2}$ or 340A.404, subdivision 10
(4) the pessession or tuse of aleohelie beverages in an aleohet use awareness pregram that is held at a pert-secondary sehoel, sponsored or approved by the seheol, and linited to persons 21 yeans old or older.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following final enactment and apply to actions occurring on or after that date.
