- (c) The trail shall be developed primarily for hiking and nonmotorized riding.
- Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1992, section 85.015, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:
- Subd. 18. PRAIRIE WILDFLOWER TRAIL, MOWER, DODGE, STEELE AND RICE COUNTIES. (a) The trail shall follow an abandoned rail-road line originating in the city of Austin and extending northwesterly through Blooming Prairie and Owatonna to the city of Faribault.
- (b) The trail shall be developed primarily for hiking and nonmotorized riding.

An act relating to education; permitting school boards to begin the 1994-1995 school year before Labor Day.

For the 1994-1995 school year, a school board may begin the elementary or secondary school year on the Thursday or Friday prior to Labor Day.
