The governing body of any port authority, seaway port authority, economic development authority, <u>watershed district</u>, <u>soil</u> and <u>water</u> <u>conservation district</u>, town, school district, hospital district, county, or city, by unanimous vote, may contract for goods or services with an interested officer of the governmental unit in any of the following cases.

Subd. 4. ACCOUNTS; AUDITS. The council shall keep an accurate account of its receipts and disbursements. Disbursements of council money must be made by check or by electronic funds transfer, signed or authorized by the chair or vice-chair of the council, and countersigned or authorized by its regional administrator or designee after whatever auditing and approval of the expenditure may be required by the council.
