Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 135.44, Subdivision 1, as amended by Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 50, Section 10, is amended to read:

135.44 Retirement benefit. Subdivision 1. **Requirements as to age and service.** Any member or former member who ceases or has ceased to render teaching services either before or after July 1, 1959 in any school or institution covered by Minnesota Statutes, Sections 135.01 to 135.18 and 135.31 to 135.55, *and acts amendatory thereof*, and who has attained the age of at least 55 years with not less than ten years allowable service, or who has received credit for not less than 30 years allowable service regardless of age, is entitled upon written application to a retirement annuity.

Sec. 4. *This act takes effect upon final enactment.*

CHAPTER 746—S. F. No. 1166

An act relating to the public employees retirement association; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 353.01, Subdivision 6, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 353.01, Subdivision 6, as amended by Laws 1959, Chapter 650, Section 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 6. "Governmental subdivision" means a county, city, village, borough, town, school district within this state, or a department or unit of state government or any other public body employing any person who is a public employee by virtue of specific authorization made in section 353.01,

subdivision 2, but does not mean any municipal housing and redevelopment authority organized under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 462.415 to 462.711; or any seaway port authority organized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 458; or any soil conservation district organized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 40; or ~~to~~ any hospital district organized or reorganized pursuant to legislation enacted by the 1959 Legislature.

Sec. 2. *The legislative intent is hereby declared that at no time were employees of any port authority organized under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 458 eligible to membership in the public employees retirement association, that the restricted reference in Laws 1959, Chapter 650, Section 2 "any seaway port authority" was an inadvertence and should have read "any port authority."*

An act relating to the firemen's relief association in the city of South Saint Paul; amending Laws 1943, Chapter 397, Section 1, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1943, Chapter 397, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1947, Chapter 274, Section 1; Laws 1953, Chapter 44, Section 1; and Laws 1957, Chapter 127, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **South Saint Paul, firemen's relief association.** ~~The fire department of each the city of the third class in this state having an assessed valuation of over \$10,000,000 and less than \$15,000,000 employing sixteen or more regular and fully paid firemen and having a population of not less than 15,000 and not more than 18,000 according to the last Federal census South Saint Paul, shall maintain a firemen's relief association which shall be duly incorporated under the laws of the state of Minnesota. All such corporations, or hereafter incorporated under the laws of this state, shall have perpetual existence.~~
