1.6	Section 1. WALDORF; STREET AND SEWER IMPROVEMENTS.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,699,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Waldorf to design, construct, and
1.9	equip a stabilization pond system, wastewater collection system, a water treatment and
1.10	distribution system, storm water drainage systems, street replacement, and other capital
1.11	improvements to publicly owned infrastructure.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.13	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.14	the state in an amount up to \$3,699,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.15	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
