BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. COMO ZOO HABITAT PRESERVATION EXHIBIT RENOVATION,

1.6

PHASE 1.

1.7

Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$14,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

1.8

fund to the Metropolitan Council for a grant to the city of Saint Paul for predesign, design,

1.9

and engineering of Phase 1 of the renovation of habitat preservation at the Como Zoo. The

1.10

renovated habitat preservation will support the zoo education programs.

1.11

Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

1.12

bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue

1.13

bonds of the state in an amount up to \$14,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with

1.14

the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the

Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
