Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, 1.7 a brewer licensed under section 340A.301, subdivision 6, clause (c), (i), or (j), that produces 1.8 7,500 barrels or less of malt liquor annually may be issued a license by the commissioner 1.9 of public safety for off-sale of malt liquor at its licensed premises that has been produced 1.10 and packaged by the brewer, as provided in subdivision 2. The amount of malt liquor sold 1.11 at off-sale under this section is not subject to the annual barrel limit imposed in section 1.12 340A.28, subdivision 1. 1.13 Subd. 2. Packaging.
