1.7	Subd. 2. Allocation of revenues. (a) \$33,760,000, or 70 percent, whichever is greater,
1.8	Of the amounts remitted under this chapter, 75 percent in fiscal years 2020 and 2021, 80
1.9	percent in fiscal years 2022 and 2023, and 100 percent thereafter must be credited to the
1.10	environmental fund established in section 16A.531, subdivision 1.
1.11	(b) The remainder in fiscal years 2020 to 2023 must be deposited into the general fund.
1.12	(c) Beginning in fiscal year 2020 and continuing each year thereafter, the difference
1.13	between the amount deposited in the environmental fund under paragraph (a) and the amount
