1.8	seeds which are treated, for which a separate label may be used, the label must contain:
1.9	(1) a word or statement to indicate that the seed has been treated;
1.10	(2) the commonly accepted, coined, chemical, or abbreviated generic chemical name of
1.11	the applied substance;
1.12	(3) the caution statement "Do not use for food, feed, or oil purposes" if the substance in
1.13	the amount present with the seed is harmful to human or other vertebrate animals;
1.14	(4) in the case of mercurials or similarly toxic substances, a poison statement and symbol;
1.15	(5) a word or statement describing the process used when the treatment is not of pesticide
