

(b) By majority vote of ~~each house~~ both bodies of the legislature, the legislature may ~~terminate~~ extend a peacetime emergency ~~extending~~ beyond ~~30~~ 14 days. If the governor determines a need to extend the peacetime emergency declaration beyond ~~30~~ 14 days and the legislature is not sitting in session, the governor must issue a call immediately convening both houses of the legislature. The legislature may extend the duration of the peacetime emergency for at least 14 days but not more than 30 days. Nothing in this section limits the governor's authority over or command of the National Guard as described in the Military Code, chapters 190 to 192A, and required by the Minnesota Constitution, article V, section 3.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment and applies to peacetime emergencies in effect or declared on or after that date.
