1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 116.03, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 7. Clean Air Act settlement money. "Clean Air Act settlement money" means
1.9 money received by or required to be paid to the state as a result of litigation or settlements
1.10 of alleged violations of the federal Clean Air Act, United States Code, title 42, section 7401,
1.11 et seq., or rules adopted thereunder, by an automobile manufacturer. Clean Air Act settlement
1.12 money may not be spent until it is specifically appropriated by law.
