1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to education; clarifying continuing education requirements for substitute  
 1.3 principals; amending Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 122A.14, subdivision 3.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 122A.14, subdivision 3, is amended to  
 1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Rules for continuing education requirements.** The board shall  
 1.8 adopt rules establishing continuing education requirements that promote continuous  
 1.9 improvement and acquisition of new and relevant skills by school administrators. A  
 1.10 retired school principal who serves as a substitute principal or assistant principal for the  
 1.11 same person on a day-to-day basis for no more than 15 consecutive school days is not  
 1.12 subject to continuing education requirements as a condition of serving as a substitute  
 1.13 principal or assistant principal.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
