Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 119B.09, subdivision 10, as amended by 1.6 Laws 2011, First Special Session chapter 9, article 1, section 4, is amended to read: 1.7 Subd. 10. Payment of funds. All federal, state, and local child care funds must 1.8 be paid directly to the parent when a provider cares for children in the children's own 1.9 home. In all other cases, all federal, state, and local child care funds must be paid directly 1.10 to the child care provider, either licensed or legal nonlicensed, on behalf of the eligible 1.11 family. Funds distributed under this chapter must not be used for child care services 1.12 that are provided for a child by a child care provider who resides in the same household 1.13 or occupies the same residence as the child. Union dues or fair share fees may not be 1.14 deducted from funds distributed under this chapter. 1.15

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
