1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 16B.98, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8	Subd. 12. Report to the legislature and attorney general. A granting agency must
1.9	include in a grant agreement a requirement that the grantee submit an annual report to the
1.10	attorney general and to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees
1.11	with jurisdiction over the granting agency. The annual report must detail the total amount
1.12	of the grant awarded to the grantee, how the grant was used, and must include a copy of the
1.13	grantee's most recent IRS form 990. The granting agency must provide the grantee with
1.14	information on how to properly deliver the reports required by this subdivision.
1.15	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2023, and applies to grant
1.16	agreements executed on or after that date.
