1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 256B.0625, is amended by adding a
1.7 subdivision to read:

1.8 Subd. 64. **Detoxification services.** Effective upon federal approval, medical
1.9 assistance covers services provided by detoxification programs licensed under Minnesota
1.10 Rules, parts 9530.6510 to 9530.6590. The commissioner shall seek the necessary federal
1.11 approval to implement this subdivision.
