1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 297H.13, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 2. Allocation of revenues. (a) <del>\$33,760,000, or 70 percent, whichever is greater,</del>
1.8	Of the amounts remitted under this chapter, 85 percent in fiscal year 2023 and 100 percent
1.9	in fiscal year 2024 and thereafter must be credited to the environmental fund established in
1.10	section 16A.531, subdivision 1.
1.11	(b) The remainder in fiscal year 2023 must be deposited into the general fund.
1.12	(c) Beginning in fiscal year 2023 and continuing each year thereafter, the difference
1.13	between the amount deposited in the environmental fund under paragraph (a) and the amount
1.14	that would have been deposited under paragraph (a) before being amended by this act must
1.15	be expended on activities listed in section 115A.557, subdivision 2, paragraph (a), clauses
1.16	(1) to (7) and (9) to (11).
1.17	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
