1.5	Section 1. PALACE THEATER.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$6,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city
1.8	of St. Paul to design, construct, furnish, and equip the renovation of the Palace Theater.
1.9	This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of management and budget
1.10	determines that at least an equal amount has been committed from nonstate sources.
1.11	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.12	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.13	bonds of the state in an amount up to \$6,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
