1.8	Subdivision 1. Definition. For the purposes of this section, "Minnesota health care				
1.9	programs" means publicly funded health care programs administered by the commissioner				
1.10	of human services under chapters 256B, 256L, 256R, and 256S, and the Minnesota restricted				
1.11	recipients program.				
1.12	Subd. 2. Establishment. The Minnesota health care programs special revenue fund is				
1.13	created as a special revenue fund in the state treasury to provide an additional source of				
1.14	public money for initiatives relating to Minnesota health care programs. The commissioner				
1.15	of human services may expend money appropriated from the Minnesota health care programs				
1.16	special revenue fund only for purposes specified in law.				
1.17	Subd. 3. Revenue. The state share of all money recovered by the commissioner of human
