 1.2 relating to crime; clarifying military member and adding veterans to offense of
 1.3 impersonation; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 609.475.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 609.475, is amended to read:

1.6 **609.475 IMPERSONATING POLICE OFFICER; MILITARY.**

1.7 Whoever falsely impersonates a police ~~or military~~ officer, active or reserve
 1.8 component military service member, veteran, or public official with intent to mislead
 1.9 another into believing that the impersonator is actually such officer, service member,
 1.10 veteran, or official is guilty of a misdemeanor.
