1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to agriculture; clarifying that commercial animal feed may contain industrial
1.3 hemp; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 25.33, subdivisions 6, 8, by
1.4 adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 25.33, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 6. **Feed ingredient.** "Feed ingredient" means each of the constituent materials
1.8 making up a commercial feed. Feed ingredient includes industrial hemp for:

1.9 (1) pet and horse feed, including specialty feed; and

1.10 (2) other livestock when the United States Food and Drug Administration approves
1.11 industrial hemp as a feed ingredient for other livestock.

1.12 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 25.33, subdivision 8, is amended to read:

1.13 Subd. 8. **Drug.** "Drug" means (1) any article intended for use in the diagnosis, cure,
1.14 mitigation, treatment, or prevention of disease in animals other than humans; and (2) articles
1.15 other than feed intended to affect the structure or any function of the animal body. Drug
1.16 does not include industrial hemp.

1.17 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 25.33, is amended by adding a subdivision to
1.18 read:

1.19 Subd. 9a. **Industrial hemp.** "Industrial hemp" has the meaning given in section 18K.02,
1.20 subdivision 3.
