1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to public safety; increasing penalties for attempting to hire a minor for
 1.3 prostitution; amending Minnesota Statutes 2015 Supplement, section 609.324,
 1.4 subdivision 1.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2015 Supplement, section 609.324, subdivision 1,
 1.7 is amended to read:

1.8 Subdivision 1. **Engaging in, hiring, or agreeing to hire minor to engage in**
 1.9 **prostitution; penalties.** (a) Whoever intentionally does any of the following may be
 1.10 sentenced to imprisonment for not more than 20 years or to payment of a fine of not
 1.11 more than \$40,000, or both:

1.12 (1) engages in prostitution with an individual under the age of 13 years; ~~or~~

1.13 (2) hires or offers or agrees to hire an individual under the age of 13 years to engage
 1.14 in sexual penetration or sexual contact; or

1.15 (3) hires or offers or agrees to hire an individual who the actor reasonably believes
 1.16 to be under the age of 13 years to engage in sexual penetration or sexual contact.

1.17 (b) Whoever intentionally does any of the following may be sentenced to
 1.18 imprisonment for not more than ten years or to payment of a fine of not more than
 1.19 \$20,000, or both:

1.20 (1) engages in prostitution with an individual under the age of 16 years but at least
 1.21 13 years; ~~or~~

1.22 (2) hires or offers or agrees to hire an individual under the age of 16 years but at
 1.23 least 13 years to engage in sexual penetration or sexual contact; or

2.1 (3) hires or offers or agrees to hire an individual who the actor reasonably believes
2.2 to be under the age of 16 years but at least 13 years to engage in sexual penetration or
2.3 sexual contact.

2.4 (c) Whoever intentionally does any of the following may be sentenced to
2.5 imprisonment for not more than five years or to payment of a fine of not more than
2.6 \$10,000, or both:

2.7 (1) engages in prostitution with an individual under the age of 18 years but at least
2.8 16 years;

2.9 (2) hires or offers or agrees to hire an individual under the age of 18 years but at
2.10 least 16 years to engage in sexual penetration or sexual contact; or

2.11 (3) hires or offers or agrees to hire an individual who the actor reasonably believes
2.12 to be under the age of 18 years but at least 16 years to engage in sexual penetration or
2.13 sexual contact.

2.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2016, and applies to crimes
2.15 committed on or after that date.
