.7	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$5,741,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
.8	fund to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of St. Louis Park to
.9	acquire land, design, construct, furnish, and equip improvements to a transit station along
.10	a light rail line at Wooddale Avenue, including safety and circulation improvements at
.11	Wooddale and Highway 7, a stairway connection to the Cedar Lake Regional Trail, and
.12	relocation of utilities. This appropriation is not available until at least an equal amount is
.13	committed from nonstate sources.
.14	Subd. 2. <b>Bond sale.</b> To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
