- 1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. LEAD TACKLE TRADE-IN PROGRAM.

\$...... in fiscal year 2021 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of natural resources to establish a lead tackle trade-in program that allows a person to exchange lead tackle for nontoxic fishing tackle or for a voucher or coupon for nontoxic fishing tackle. The commissioner must work with fishing tackle manufacturers, fishing tackle retailers, conservation organizations, and other interested parties in establishing the program. Trade-in locations must be located statewide. The program must ensure safe handling and disposal of lead tackle exchanged as part of the program. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2022.
