1.9	minimum time to eat lunch does not include transition time to and from the cafeteria or
1.10	other place where lunch is served, waiting in a food service line, selecting the meal, returning
1.11	trays, or recess.
1.12	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2024.
