1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to public safety; providing restitution for public agencies and victims
1.3 affected by the reporting of a fictitious emergency; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.4 2022, section 609.78, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.78, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 2c. Restitution. (a) The court, while imposing a sentence on a person convicted
1.9 under subdivision 2, clause (2), shall order the person to make full and complete restitution
1.10 to:

1.11 (1) the public agency for the reasonable costs of the emergency response by that public
1.12 agency; and

1.13 (2) a direct victim of the fictitious emergency.

1.14 (b) A restitution payment under paragraph (a) does not limit the liability for damages
1.15 in a civil action or proceeding for an amount greater than the restitution payment.
