1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to human services; authorizing supplemental rental assistance for  
1.3 individuals experiencing long-term homelessness; amending Minnesota Statutes  
1.4 2016, section 256I.05, subdivision 1g.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 256I.05, subdivision 1g, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 1g. **Supplementary service rate for certain facilities.** An agency may negotiate  
1.8 a supplementary service rate for recipients of assistance under section 256I.04, subdivision  
1.9 1, paragraph (a) or (b), who have experienced long-term homelessness and who live in a  
1.10 supportive housing establishment under section 256I.04, subdivision 2a, paragraph (b),  
1.11 clause (2). An agency may provide supplemental rental assistance of up to \$50 per month  
1.12 to ensure housing stability for recipients eligible for assistance under this subdivision.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2018.
