- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to transportation; establishing a moratorium on permits to mow or hay
- 1.3 trunk highway rights-of-way.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **TRUNK HIGHWAY MOWING OR HAYING; PERMIT MORATORIUM.**
- 1.6 (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), the commissioner of transportation must
- 1.7 implement a moratorium until April 30, 2019, on enforcing permits under Minnesota Statutes,
- 1.8 sections 160.232 and 160.2715, or any other Minnesota statute or administrative rule, to
- 1.9 mow or bale hay in the right-of-way of a trunk highway.
- 1.10 (b) This section applies regardless of the date of any permit issuance. This section does
- 1.11 not apply to a right-of-way adjacent to land under the jurisdiction of the state or a political
- 1.12 subdivision.
- 1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
