The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Capital Investment

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a national loon center in
- 1.3 the city of Crosslake; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **NATIONAL LOON CENTER IN THE CITY OF CROSSLAKE.**
- 1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$7,900,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.7 to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to the city of Crosslake for site
- 1.8 preparation and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a new building and
- 1.9 adjacent outdoor public space improvements, including surface lot parking areas, in the city
- 1.10 of Crosslake to house a national loon center, to provide visitor, education, and exhibit
- 1.11 facilities for the general public, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695. This
- 1.12 appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and budget determines
- 1.13 that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project, as required by
- 1.14 Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.
- 1.15 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.16 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.17 the state in an amount up to \$7,900,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.18 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.19 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
